Applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. Programmes on GYANVEER UNIVERSITY WEBSITE from 01/08/2024 to 16/08/2024, from the eligible candidates for the Session 2024-25 as per the Ordinances No. 12.

How to Apply: Candidates desirous of seeking admission to the above programme are required to submit their application with the requisite fee (Non Refundable) of Rs. 3000/-(Three Thousands Only) for each programme on www.gyanveeruniversity.edu.in

Mode of Selection: Eligible Candidates will be called for COMMAN ENTRANCE TEST ON 25/08/2024 at the Gyanveer University, Sagar campus.

Students who have scored 50% Mark's in the Entrance Test are Eligible to be called for the Interview.

Candidates who have passed national tests (NET, GATE, etc.), state tests (MPSLET), hold a teacher fellowship, or have an M.Phil through an entrance test will be exempted from the Ph.D. entrance exam. However, they will be required to apply and pay the admission fee, They are eligible for direct interview.

Eligibility: (1) Candidates for a Doctor of Philosophy degree must have at least a master's degree (1-year/2-semester or 2-year/4-semester) after a bachelor's degree (4-year/8-semester or 3-year/6-semester) with a minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade. Alternatively, they can have equivalent qualifications from a recognized foreign institution accredited by an authorized agency in the respective country.

- (2) Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed.
- (3) Candidates with an M.Phil. degree and at least 55% marks or an equivalent grade, or an equivalent qualification from a recognized foreign institution, are eligible for admission to the Ph.D. program.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

Test Pattern: The Entrance Test shall comprise of one Multiple Choice Objective type Question paper having 100 questions of one mark each, covering all the basic papers of the Post-Graduate level of the concerned subject and Research Methodology.
